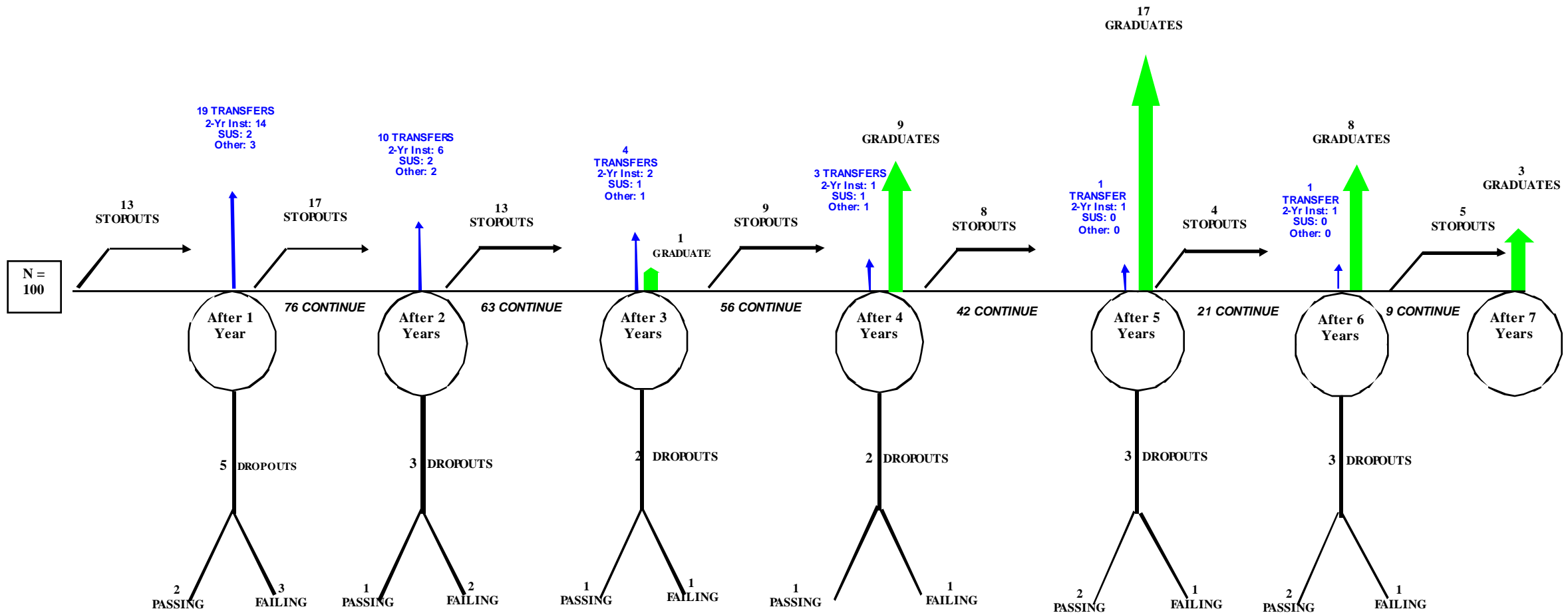


Progression of First-Time Freshmen
