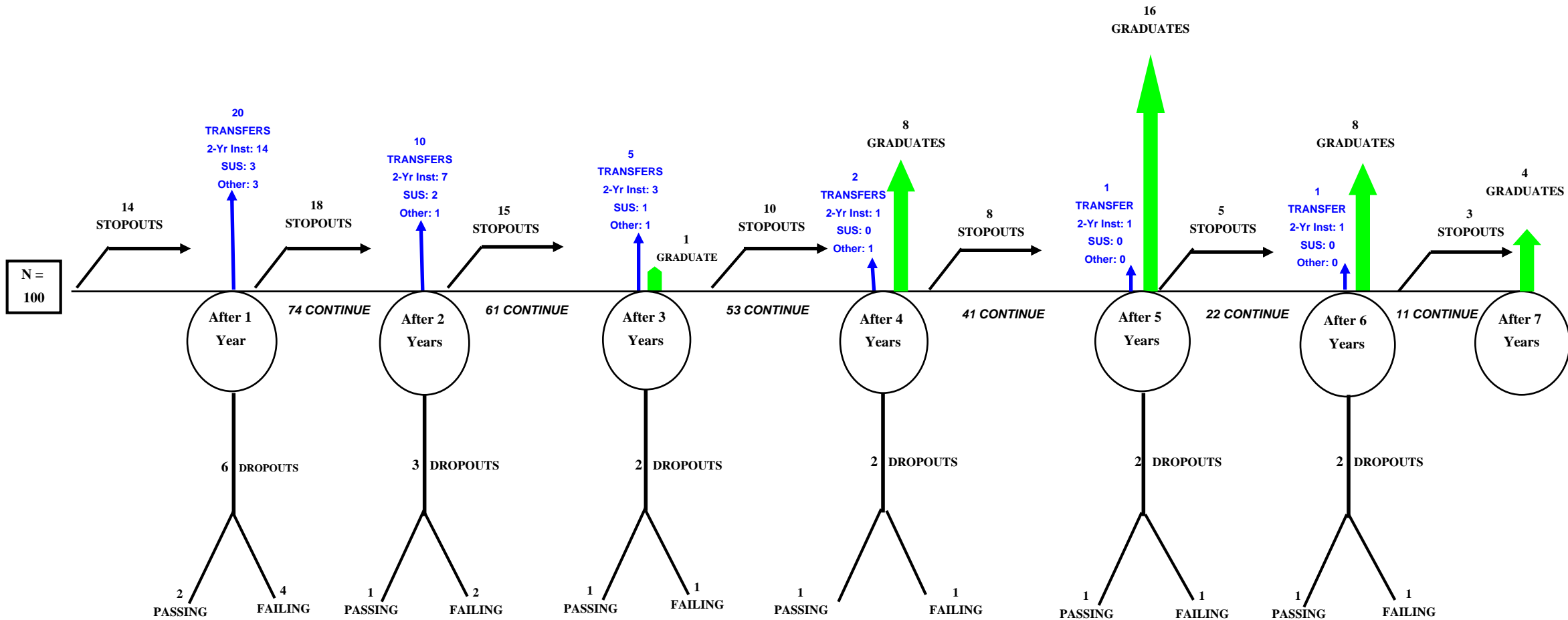


Progression of First-Time Freshmen

"Transfer" = first institution enrolled in after leaving FAU. Actual transfer enrollment may be in any subsequent term.
